Plans for a full return to school on Monday 19th April 2021

Although we are very excited to see all of our young people back at Woodfarm High School after Easter there are still some health and safety measures in place to keep us all safe in the coming months.

These measures are as follows:

Entrances and Exits

- The 3 main entrances for young people will be the same as before Christmas
- Courtyard Entrance for S1/2
- Main Entrance for S3/4
- Community Wing Entrance for S5/6
- The exits for young people will be the same as before Christmas (the one nearest exist to their classroom)

Health & Safety

- Face coverings must be worn at all times in the school building.
- Sanitising stations remain in place at all entrances.
- Any movement around school will be via our existing one way system.
- A member of SMT will allow pupils to access the building 5 minutes before the school starts each day.
- All staff will be adhering to 2m social distancing.

Hub Information

- Our Hub for children of key workers and vulnerable children will cease to operate.

Senior Phase Assessments

- Our S4/5/6 learners will be sitting a series of assessments throughout April and May. With this in mind, we would ask that the S1/2/3 learners move quietly across the school. Signs will be up throughout the school asking for calmness and silence as pupils move into certain areas of the school.

Recall of ICT devices that have been on loan to families during Covid-19

- We will be starting a programme of recall for the Chromebooks and laptops that have been given to families during lockdown. These devices are required back in school for classwork so we will be in contact with you very soon to start the process of delivering them back to the main school office.

S1/2/3 Google Classroom codes & learning

- New Google Classrooms have been set up in a new and more consistent format for post-Easter. These classrooms can be used to help our learners revise at home or see the course outline for the year or if isolation may be required the content of lessons will be on these classrooms. Codes for these new classrooms are coming out to parents later today and pupils will be given a chance to join the classrooms in PSHE lessons after Easter.
