Curriculum News



The pupils have settled well to primary 6 and it has been lovely seeing them re-connect with their peers and the different staff members. There will be a focus on the health and wellbeing of the pupils. We have been impressed by how well the class have learned the new routines and are taking care of their safety and of the safety of those around them.

<u>Literacy</u>: Across all curricular areas pupils will continue to explore a wide range of texts, developing reading and comprehension skills. Each week pupils will be led through guided reading, spelling, grammar, talking & listening and writing experiences. On Tuesday we will focus specifically on developing writing skills through Big Writing.

Numeracy: We will be starting this year by revising our number skills and using them in a variety of contexts. We will be developing our problem solving skills and there will also be a focus on mental math with regular Number Talks inputs. We will also be making links between the maths in class and real life contexts.

<u>Health & Wellbeing:</u> We will be considering the different experiences that we have been through during the pandemic and will look at strategies that we can use to make ourselves stronger to face difficult experiences. We will have time to reconnect with others and develop our mental health along with our physical health and wellbeing.

<u>Outdoor Learning:</u> A great deal of our learning will take place outside and we ask that all pupils have suitable clothing and shoes to ensure that we can access the outdoors in all weathers.

Primary 6 will have three teachers working with the class. Mrs Murdoch will be the class teacher on a Monday, Tuesday and alternate Wednesday with Mrs Gardner being in class on the alternate Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Mr Stevenson will also be working with the class. We are looking forward to a busy year together.
