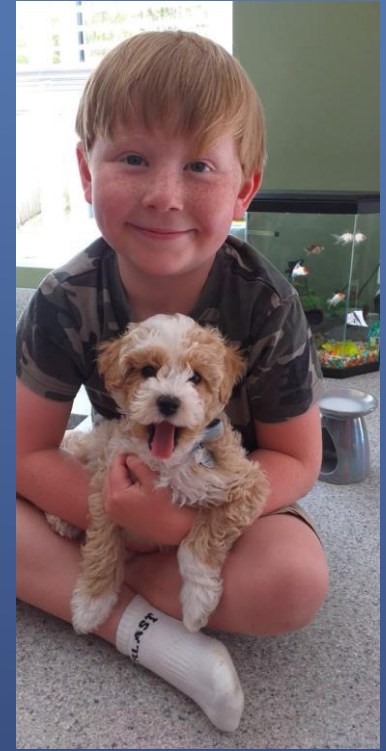


# Primary 5 - special Tweet !
