Curriculum News



The pupils are settling well into Primary 2 and are very excited to be back at school. Since returning to school the children have embraced the challenges of Primary 2 so far and have had lots of fun getting to know their peers and school staff a little better. The children show great enthusiasm towards their learning and are excited for all that awaits them in their second year of primary school. Many thanks for your continued support.

Literacy : Across all curricular areas pupils will continue to explore a wide range of how sounds work together to help them read and write. Each week pupils will be led through guided reading sessions as a class, spelling, grammar, talking & listening and writing experiences. On Thursday we will focus specifically on developing writing skills.

Numeracy: Exploring number will be at the heart of our numeracy experiences this coming term. We will be exploring numbers to help us to count, explore sequences and describe order up to 20. Practical materials will be used to help us count on and back to help us understand addition and subtraction calculations. Children will be making links to real life and becoming more aware of the importance of maths in the world around us.

Health & Wellbeing: Health & Wellbeing will be particularly important to ensure our learners feel safe and reconnected. We have been exploring the relationships we have with those around us particularly our peers and those within our school community. Alongside our **Resilience** programme we have been learning strategies that help us work through various situations that may arise in our friendships and relationships in and out of school.

<u>Social Studies:</u> We are very excited to start our topic on Under the Sea where this week we will be learning about the classification of living and non-living things.
