School Equipment

Children must have a full water bottle with them as there will be no access to water fountains initially. Your child's class teacher will issue details of P.E. and Outdoor Learning days over the next week.

Mobile Phones

Please could we ask that children do not attend school with a mobile phone. If you feel your child has to bring their mobile phone to school with them it will be collected in and stored securely during the school day and returned to them as they leave.

Drop off and Pick up arrangements

Thank you for supporting our arrangements for the return to school, we will continue to review these and update you with any changes.

When you have dropped off or collected please help us to keep the area clear by moving on swiftly.

A gentle reminder not to use the staff car park unless the parent/carer has a disabled badge.

Please notify the school office if there are any changes to the usual home arrangements for your child.

School Lunches

Primary 1 to 3 children are entitled to free lunches. Lunches are available to all other Primary 4 to 7 children who receive Free School Meals or who wish to purchase a lunch. The lunch room will be taking part in the Government Eat Out To Help Out scheme from Monday – Wednesday in August and school lunches on these days will only be £1.05. Children are also welcome to bring a healthy snack for playtime and a packed lunch. There will be no tuck shop until further notice.
