

## **Curriculum News**



## <u>Literacy</u>

This term we will be focusing on imaginative writing, where we will be using texts and moving images to inspire us. In reading we will continue to explore fiction and non-fiction books with a focus on developing our questioning to demonstrate our understanding of the texts. We will also be making links to our Rainforest Topic where the pupils will be writing Rainforest Animal Factfiles and demonstrating our talking and listening skills when we present them.

## **Numeracy**

There was a focus on number fluency in term one and reminding ourselves of the mental-maths strategies for addition and subtraction, as well as a focus on multiplication and division. That will continue this term but we will also be looking at areas such as 2D and 3D shape, fractions, information handling and multiplying a 2 digit number by a single digit number. We have been recording the rainfall and temperature for Barrhead and the rainforest and we will be using this data to create charts and graphs in information handling.

## Health and Wellbeing

This term we will be developing our resilience in school. The pupils will be learning about the importance of resilience in all walks of life through lessons in the classroom and PE, and we will be recognising pupils who are showing resilience.

#### **Social Studies**

This term we will be learning all about the rainforest and its role on our planet. We will be exploring the plants and animals that can be found in rainforests, the different layers of the rainforest and why it makes a good home for so many different types of plants and animals. We will be making links to other areas of the curriculum through our rain forest topic. In arts and crafts we will be sketching the blue morpho butterfly and listening to our peers' feedback to improve our sketch, we will be comparing the weather of Barrhead to the weather in the Amazon rainforest using our weather gauge and making links to maths and information handling by putting our data into charts and we will be learning about taking care of plants as our links to science.
