LITERACY - This term we will be concentrating on our reading considering the skills that we need before, during and after reading. We will focus on finding the information in the passage and reading a variety of texts. We will be looking at imaginative writing and will also focus our writing on global issues in connection with the COP26.

NUMERACY - We continue to focus on our mental maths skills (any revision of multiplication tables at home would be helpful). We will also consider word problems and operations.

SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES - These areas will be connected with Science considering renewable energy and our Social Studies looking at comparing and contrasting Scotland and Malawi. This will also interlink other subject areas such as expressive arts, RME and technologies.
