### Curriculum News



We are very excited for the term ahead and P6 have lots of exciting activities planned!

**Literacy:** Pupils will continue to read a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts each week, developing reading and comprehension skills. Becoming independent learners by answering and creating questions will be a major focus and pupils will have the opportunity to complete a variety of literacy based tasks. Each week pupils will continue to be led through guided reading, spelling, grammar, talking & listening and writing experiences. Reading for enjoyment will also be a focus this term. Active spelling games will continue to be used and pupils will be encouraged to learn their new spelling words with a variety of spelling strategies.

**Numeracy:** Pupils will have a focus on mental maths and number work most days. Other topics such as shape, volume, time and fractions will be covered throughout this term. Active maths strategies and outdoor maths will be a regular occurrence throughout the term.

**Health & Wellbeing:** In Health & Wellbeing our focus this term is rights respecting the school and learning about the school values. We have discussed our class charter which pupils have created together and is something we will regularly refer throughout the year.

**Social Studies:** We have begun our new class topic on Blue Planet. This is a very relevant topic and I am excited about the various science, art, drama and social elements we are able to include. This topic is very relevant with COP 26 approaching and being able to learn about the planet we live on which links with other curricular areas. P6 are enjoying the class discussions and research we have carried out so far.

### Celebrating Achievements

We use a daily recognition board in our classroom and each week we discuss what our daily focus will be.



### Homework Hints

Homework will be issued on a Monday and returned on a Friday. There is a spelling and numeracy task for your child to complete each evening and one reading task for them to complete each week.

Please encourage your child to read a book they really enjoy at home every night if possible. We have a book wall in class and the children are encouraged to write about their current reads.

Primary 6 will have their P.E. sessions on a Tuesday and a Friday.

Both sessions will hopefully take place outdoors so pupils should bring a PE kit on these days suitable for all weather.
