Tasks:

- While watching the videos make a list of any new French vocabulary you come across and what it means in English.
- Compare primary schools in France and in Scotland. Make a list of similarities and a list of differences. As well as getting information from the videos, you can research this further on the internet to help you.
- Draw a pencil case and all the things you might find inside it e.g. pen, pencil, glue stick, scissors, pencil sharpener. Label all the items Use the internet if you need help.
- Write down the lessons/activities shown in the Marseille video clip and use these to create a timetable for a French school day. Write all the subjects in French.
- Write 4 sentences to give your opinions on school subjects like some of the children did in the video. Which subjects do you like or not like? Can you explain why? (You can use the PowerPoint attached to help you with this task.)

Examples:

- J'aime les maths parce que c'est intéressant. I like maths because it's interesting. Je n'aime pas l'histoire parce que c'est trop difficile. — I don't like history because it's too difficult.
- Imagine you are visiting a school in France. Write a short description to introduce yourself in French. Include what your name is, your age, and where you are from. Example: Bonjour je m'appelle Marie et j'ai dix ans. J'habite à Glasgow.
- Draw a picture of your classroom and label all the things inside it in French (a desk, a chair, a cupboard, a whiteboard etc.). You can use the internet to help you remember the words if you need to.
