### Photograph

It is really important that you choose an appropriate photo for your page. It must fit this criteria:

- It needs to be of just you
- It must have a plain background (a wall or the garden etc, not your bedroom)
  - It would be nice to see you smiling
  - You cannot wear a football shirt
- It cannot have a filter on it (from Snapchat or Instagram etc)
  Please make sure it fits the full photo box.

### **#PROUD**
