<p style="text-align: center;">Rainbow Writing</p> <p>Write your words using a different colour for each letter.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Pyramid Writing</p> <p>Eg. cone c co con cone</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Toss a word</p> <p>Use a ball or a teddy and throw it back and forth to an adult, spelling out each word as you throw.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bounce a Ball</p> <p>Bounce a ball and each time you bounce it, spell a letter of your word.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spelling City</p> <p>Log in to spelling city and practise your spelling words. Instructions are provided overleaf.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Skip your Words.</p> <p>Each time you jump over the skipping rope, try to say a letter of your word.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Sign your words</p> <p>Use the sign language sheet on the reverse of this page to help you spell your words in sign language.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Paint your Words</p> <p>Use paint to paint your words in as many different styles/colours as you can.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Fancy Writing</p> <p>Write your words in very fancy writing. Maybe try bubble writing or joined up writing.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Playdough Words</p> <p>Can you make your words out of playdough?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Keepy Uppies</p> <p>Try to keep a ball up whilst spelling your words. You'll need to concentrate!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Make a word search or a crossword.</p> <p>Try to make it as tricky as you can for your adult to solve!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Choosing</p> <p>Choose your own way to learn your words. Will you write them using playdough, flour or something else? Will you draw pictures for your words or a mind map? What ideas do you have?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">K-Nex/Lego</p> <p>Try to create your words using k-nex or lego.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Word Process</p> <p>Try to type your words out on a laptop, phone or tablet.</p>

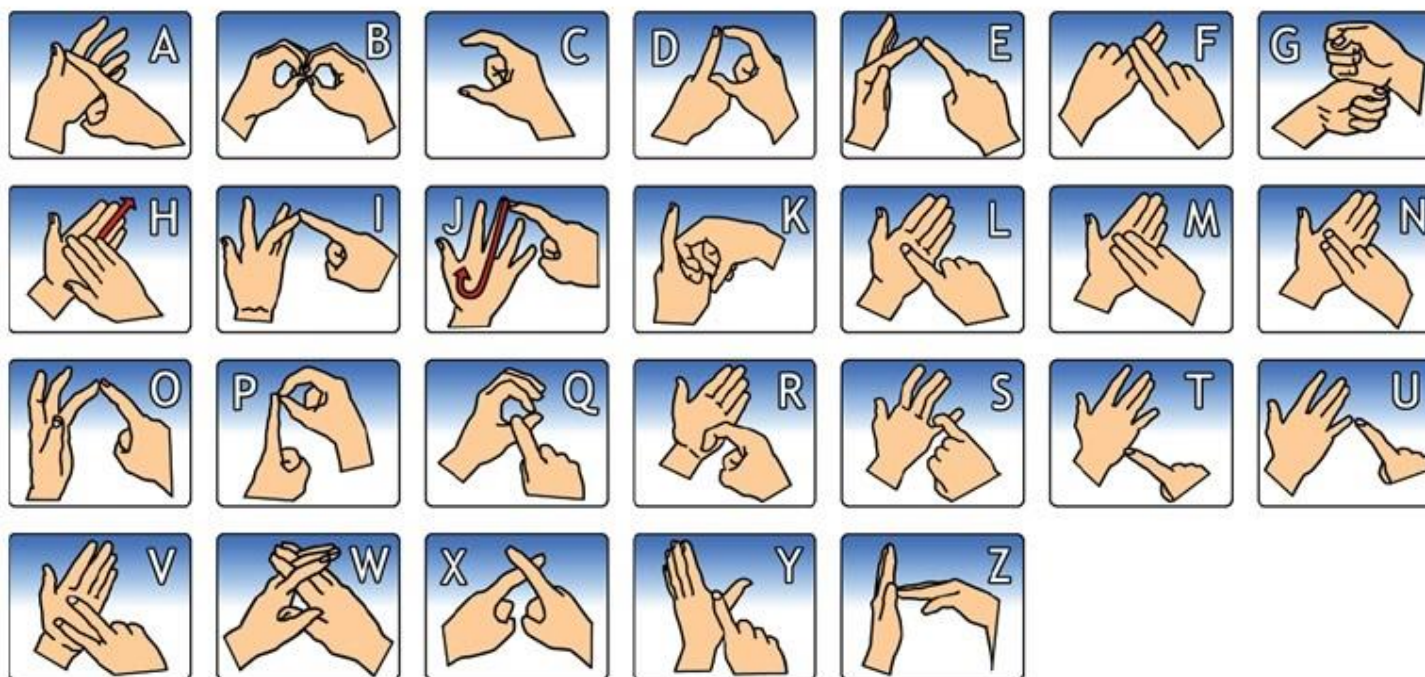
To play a game, follow these instructions
