Common Nouns and Proper Nouns

Common nouns are the names of things e.g. rabbit, tree, bed, chair, apple.

Proper nouns are the names of people or places e.g. Sam, Mr Messy, Glasgow, Mars, Kirkhill Road. Proper nouns must begin with a capital letter.
