

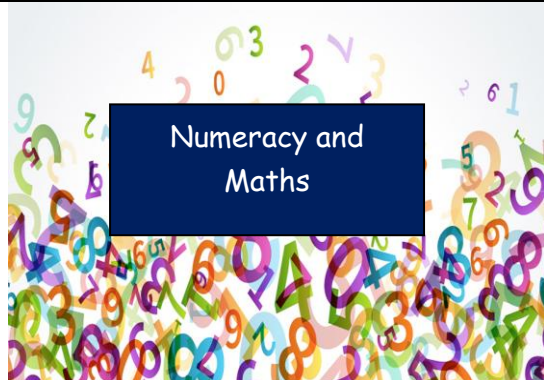

- Play some games on Sumdog to test your skills.
- Try the Got it game:

How do you play?

You'll need something to keep score with to play with a family member or the online game to play against the computer (<https://nrich.maths.org/gotit/>)

Start with the Got It target 23. The adult chooses a whole number from 1 to 4. Then take turns to add a whole number from 1 to 4 to the running total. The person who hits the target of 23 wins the game. Play the game several times, swapping who goes first. To change the game, choose a new Got It target or a new range of numbers to add on.

Can you find a winning strategy?

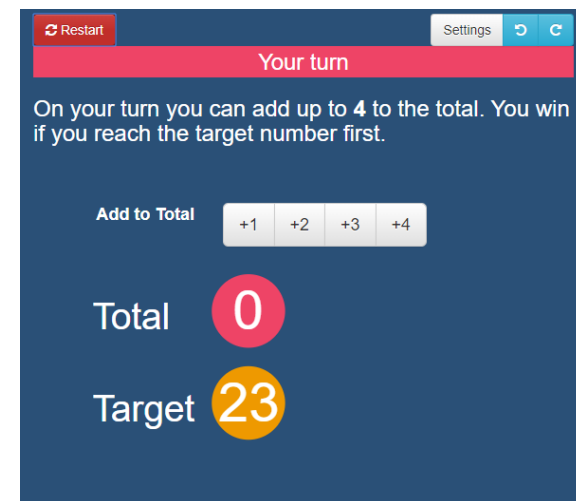
Can you always win?

stall, star, start, stay, steam, steep, still, stop, stray, stream, street, string, strong

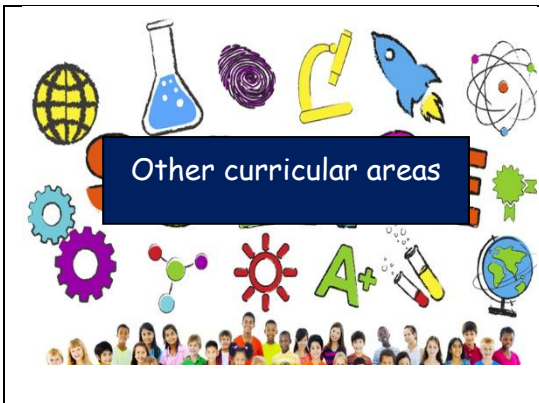
