<b>Maths</b> 	<p>This week we would like the children to practise telling the time on analogue and digital clocks. There is a link which will lead each group to the correct worksheet. One of them is a calendar activity because using calendars is a useful life skill too!</p> <p>Why not practise telling the time at home too? Keep looking at clocks and watches and see if you know what the time is.</p>
