Numeracy and Maths	<p>Mental Maths- Practise some of your multiplication tables then make up some division calculations using these tables. Practise counting backwards in tens like this - 80, 70, 60... or like this - 63, 53, 43... Why not try it like this too - 110, 100, 90... or this - 227, 217, 207... ?</p> <p>Skill - Working With Time Login to Education City and click the Homework icon. Choose from the Mild, Hot or Extra Hot options or try all three to REALLY sharpen your skills! (The activity sheets are posted on Seesaw too, although Education City has now been upgraded and should be able to cope with lots of children using it at the same time.)</p>

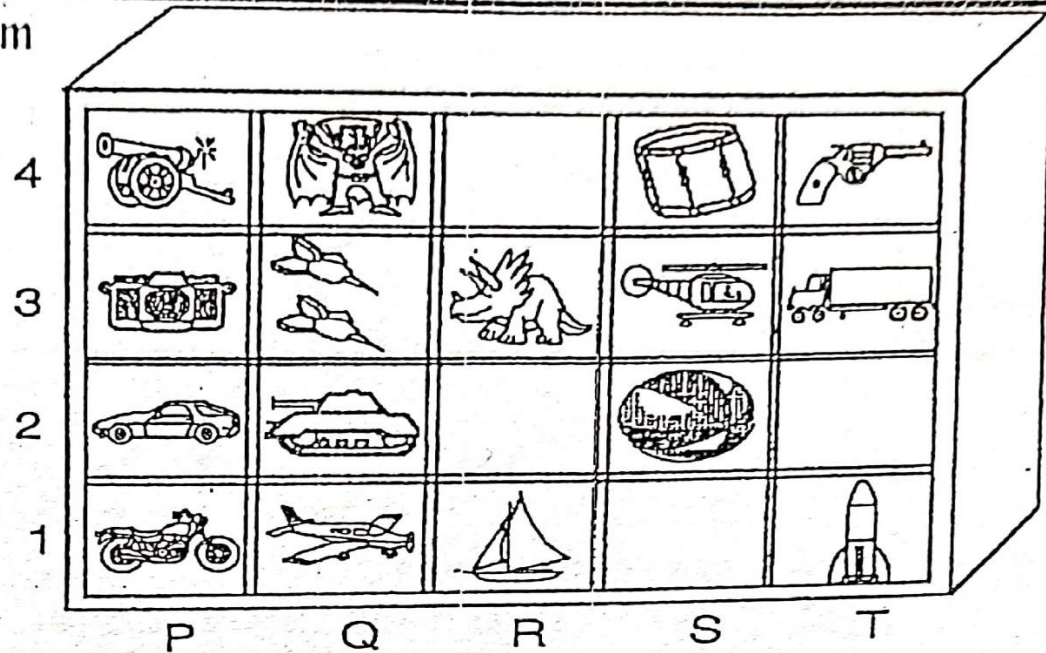

Can you see it?

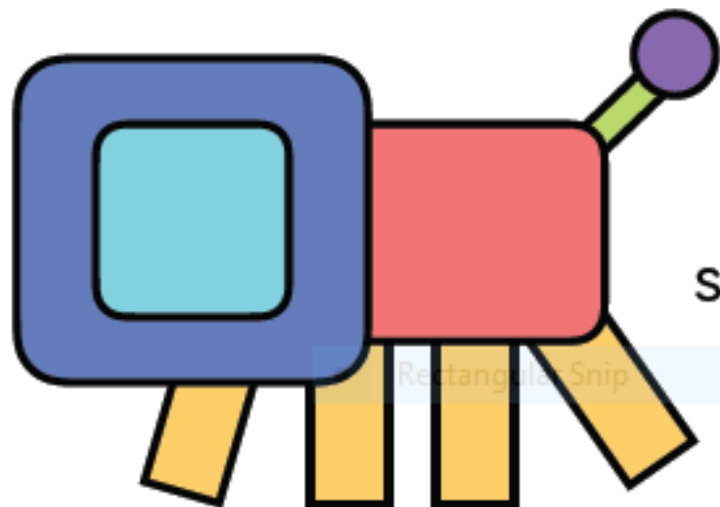
