

Adjectives and Adverbs (Revisited!)

We use **adjectives** to describe **nouns**. e.g a **wicked witch**.
Choose some *interesting* **adjectives** to complete these sentences.

7. **Cool** , **feathery** twigs lightly brushed my face.
8. Round the corner galloped a **joyful** , **scruffy** dog!

We use **adverbs** to describe **verbs**. e.g The tiger **roared angrily**.

3. The witch cackled **evilly** as she stirred her cauldron.
4. We all laughed **gleefully** when he fell off the chair.
5. **Carefully** he sliced the cake into two pieces.
6. The wolf threw back his head and howled **mournfully** .
7. **Slowly**, **skilfully** she climbed the gnarly trunk of the tree.
8. The lizard basked **lazily** and **contentedly** in the hot sun.
