Hot Spelling Task - Look at the list B words. If there is **one vowel before the last letter**, you should **double the last letter** then add -er. Examples

r <u>u</u> n	yes	runner
sh <u>o</u> p	yes	shopper
si <u>n</u> g	no, n is not a vowel	singer
r <u>ea</u> d	no, there are two vowels	reader

Look at the List C words. If the word ends in e you should take off the e, then add ing.

measure + ing = measuring take off the e and add -ing

butter + ing = buttering

no e at the end so just add -ing
