Tasks

Skill –Right angles in pathways

Practical- Play a game of Times Tables bingo with an adult or sibling on a whiteboard or piece of paper split into 6 sections-

Mild- Use the 3 or 4 times tables
Hot- Use 6 or 7 times tables
Extra Hot- Use 7 or 8 times tables

Written- Complete the Right Angles Pathway worksheet

Play the game- Ask an adult to: Dot various objects around the garden and give clues written on a 'treasure map' for reaching the objects. Follow the instructions carefully to find the 'treasure'. Now ask the adult to have a go at finding a go! Give clear instructions using forward, right, left commands i.e. Forward 3 Right 2 Forward 5

Complete the cloze passage about the Water Cycle. Choose from Very Hot, Hot or Mild challenge.

Handwriting- Practise joining to the letter e-

Can you write silly sentences using the following words-
