

## Piet Mondrain Painting Activity

(use felt pens if you don't have paint)





Text can be hard to read, here are the steps typed out clearer.

You will need: a sheet of paper, some masking tape and paint (red, yellow, blue and black).

- 1. Lay the masking tape in straight lines over the paper to make square and rectangular sections.
- 2. Choose which primary colour you want to go in each box and paint them in. You can paint some boxes black too if you want.
- 3. When the paint is dry you can carefully remove the masking tape. Be careful not to rip the paper.
- 4. Use a ruler and felt pen to draw straight lines around and between the shapes.
- 5. You now have a piece of artwork in the style of Mondrain! Please share on SeeSaw!
