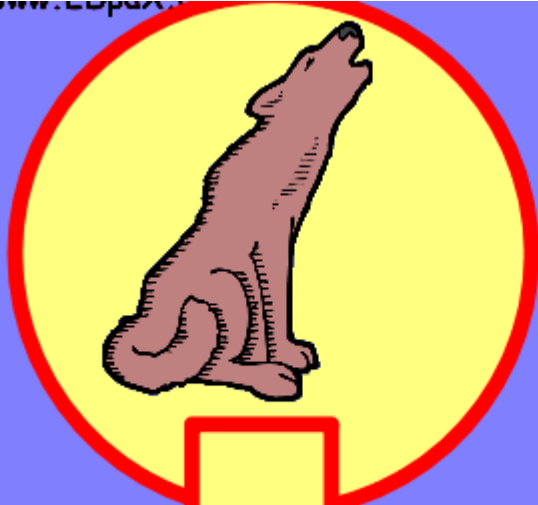

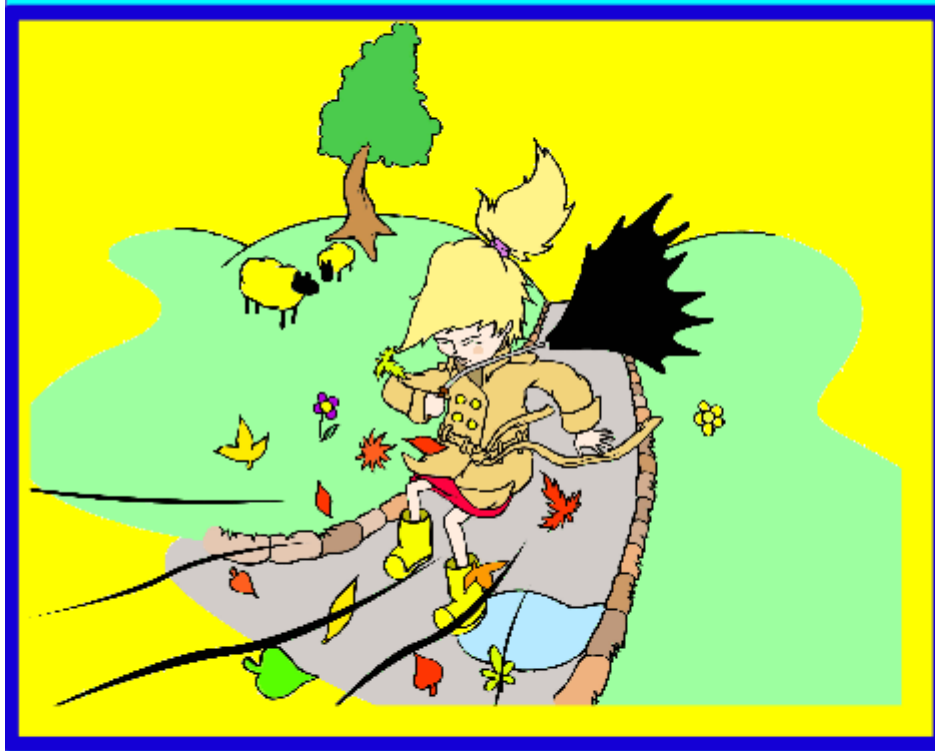

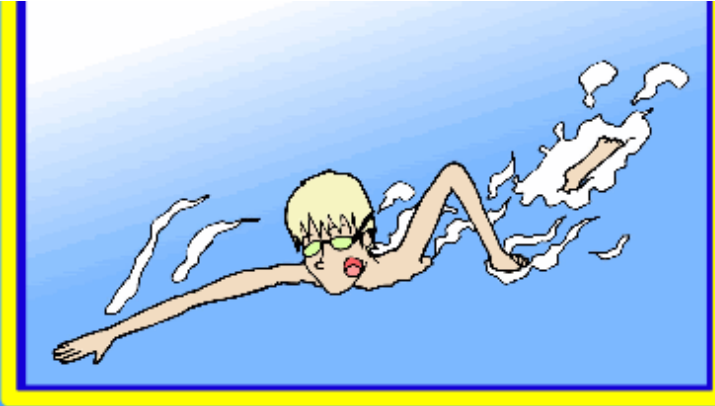


The wind is blowing.
