## PAPER CHAIN CHALLENGE

## Materials:

- 1 piece of A4 paper per person
- Scissors

- Glue or tape


## Challenge:

Create the longest paper chain using only one piece of paper. The person who makes the longest paper chain wins!

## Rules:

Extra paper is not allowed - plan carefully before you start cutting!
You have 5 minutes to plan and 30 minutes to make your paper chains. Use a timer so that everyone follows the rules.

At the end of the time everyone must stop and put their paper chains beside each other to be measured.

If a paper chain breaks during the measurement process, the person who made it has to decide which piece they want to include in the competition.

## Some optional extra challenges:

- Use a measuring tape to measure and record each one. Or count how many links are on each chain.
- Subtract the shortest from the longest.
- Add all of the lengths together.
- Estimate how many sheets of paper it would take to make a chain as long as the room using the chain you made to help you.
