




Curricular Area	Tasks
 <p>Numeracy and Maths</p>	<p><u>PROBLEM SOLVING WEEK</u></p> <p>Complete a maths activity from your Owl grid.</p>
 <p>Literacy and English</p>	<p>Active Spelling Using a timer, see how many times you can write your words correctly in one minute. Can you beat your score?</p> <p>Writing Granny and Granda are thinking of having a movie afternoon but they are looking for some film recommendations. Can you tell them about your favourite Disney film and try to persuade them to choose yours as the one they will watch? You will need to tell them:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the name of your favourite film - the names of the main characters - what happens in the story (without spoiling the ending!) - why you think they will like it - why it is your favourite <p>Remember punctuation, super spelling and stay neat!</p>
