




Curricular Area	Tasks
 <p>Numeracy and Maths</p>	<p>Capacity</p> <p>What empty containers can you find in your house? Put them in what you think is their order of capacity from smallest to largest.</p> <p>Now use a measuring jug to find out how much each container actually holds. Were you correct?</p>
 <p>Literacy and English</p>	<p>Phonics:</p> <p>‘wa’ – reading and spelling the words.</p> <p>Muddled letters</p> <p>Write your words in a muddled fashion e.g. beautiful could be written as befutualu. Then try to rewrite the words correctly.</p> <p>Handwriting ‘ck’</p> <p>Complete the spelling sheet on a piece of paper.</p>
