




Curricular Area	Tasks
 <p>Numeracy and Maths</p>	<p>Capacity Challenge!</p> <p>In Cliffhanger, each team had to move as much water as they could from their bucket into the bin. Try this outdoors on a nice day this week.</p> <p>Fill a jug/container with water. How much does it hold?</p> <p>Put a second empty container at the end of your garden/outside space. Put a sponge in the water.</p> <p>Now run to the other container and squeeze as much water as you can into the empty container from the sponge.</p> <p>Repeat this until the first container is empty.</p> <p>Now work out how much water you have lost!!</p>
 <p>Literacy and English</p>	<p>Phonics:</p> <p>'wa' – reading and spelling the words.</p> <p>Play hangman with someone at home using your spelling words.
