






# Curricular Areas Tasks

# Choose any of the tasks below to practice your spelling:



Alphabetical Order Write all of your spelling words in alphabetical order. (ABC)	Ambidextrous Write all of your spelling words using both your left and right hand.	Backwards Writing Write your spelling words forwards and then backwards. (e.g. dance ecnad)	Bubble Writing Write your spelling words in bubble writing.	Calligraphy Write your spelling words using your fanciest handwriting.	Chalk Writing Use some chalk to write your spelling words outside.
.Dictionary Flashcards  Make flashcards using your spelling words - the word on one side and its meaning on the other.	<u>Dot Writing</u> Write your spelling words using dots.	Garden Spelling Use things you find in your garden/local park like sticks and stones to spell your words.	Hidden Words Draw and colour a picture - try to hide as many of your spelling words as you can inside it.	Magazine Spelling  Cut out the letters  you need from an old  magazine and use  them to make your  spelling words.	Make Your Own Create your own activity to help learn your new spelling words.
Pasta Use pasta to make your different spelling words.	Picture Draw a picture of each of your spelling words to show what each one means.	Playdough Use playdough to make the letters of your spelling words, you could even try making your own playdough!	Rainbow Writing Write your spelling words with coloured pencils, a different colour for each letter.	Sand/Foam Writing  Get some sand or foam  and try writing your  spelling words in it.	Silly Sentences Write silly sentences, including your spelling words.
Singing Sing your spelling words one letter at a time.	Story Writing Write a story using all of your spelling words.	Torch Writing Find a dark room, and use a torch to practice writing your spelling words on the wall.	Typing Use different fonts to type out your spelling words on a computer or tablet.	UPPER and lower Try writing your spelling words in upper case and then lower case.	Word Search Create your own word search using your spelling words.
