




|  <p><b>Languages</b></p>                  | <p><u>Reading:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read Chapter 3 of 'The Legend of Spud Murphy' by Eoin Colfer with an adult at home, making sure to practise any tricky words. (Digital Copy of Book on Seesaw)</li> </ul> <p><u>Phonics:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Get an adult to choose three words from each of the 'magic e' sounds and write them down in a list. Think carefully about how to spell the words. See how many you get right.</li> </ul>   |
|  <p><b>Other Curricular Areas</b></p>    | <p><u>Topic - Local Area</u></p> <p>We are going to start a new topic on the local area. If you can, go out for a walk where you live and take note of the things you see.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Are there any shops? Which ones?</li> <li>• Is there any green space?</li> <li>• Are there any places of interest or sports facilities?</li> <li>• What kind of housing do you see?</li> </ul> <p>If you can't get outside for a walk you could have a think about where you normally walk to from your home.
