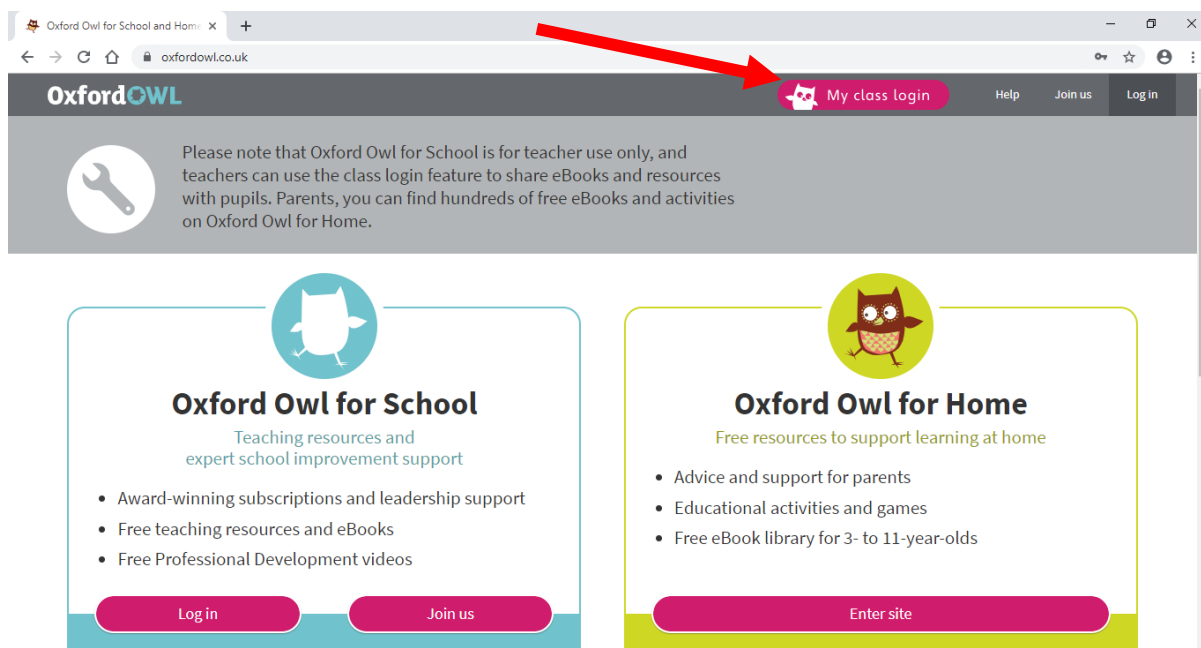


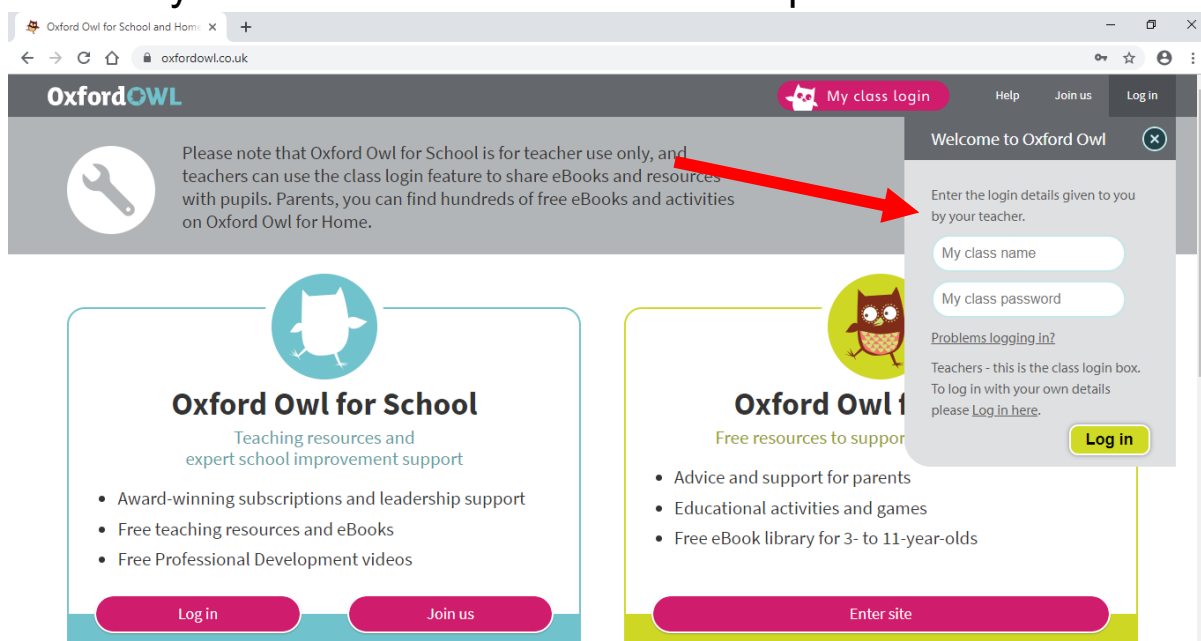
Parent instructions to log into Oxford Owls

1. Go to the website: oxfordowl.co.uk

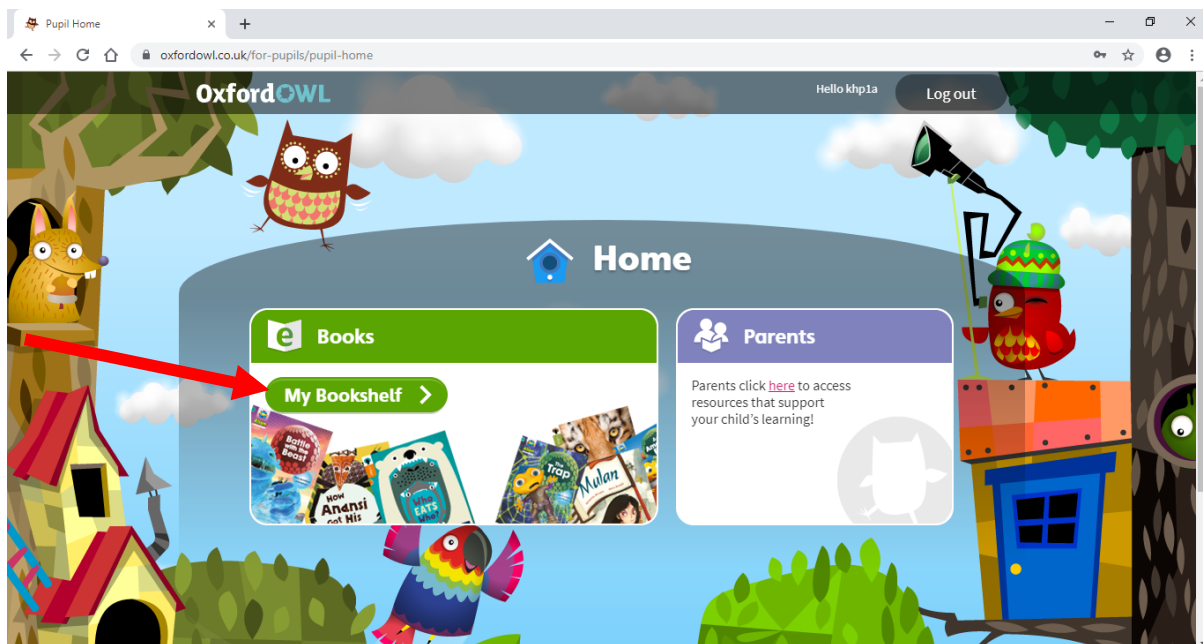
2. Click 'My class login'



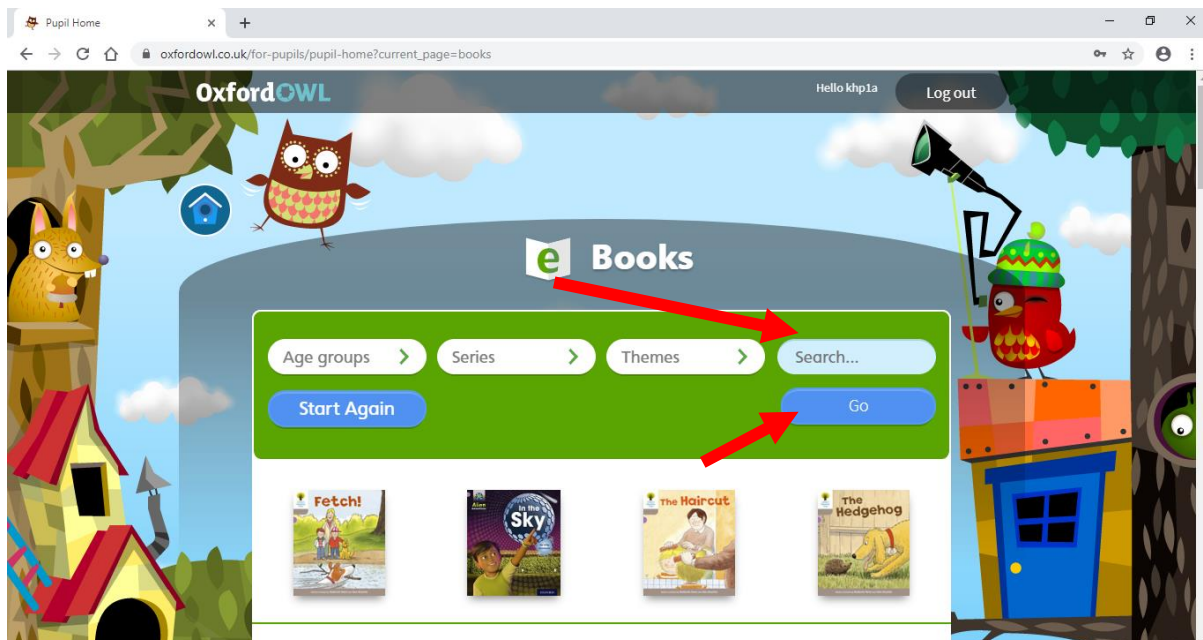
3. Enter your child's class username and password.



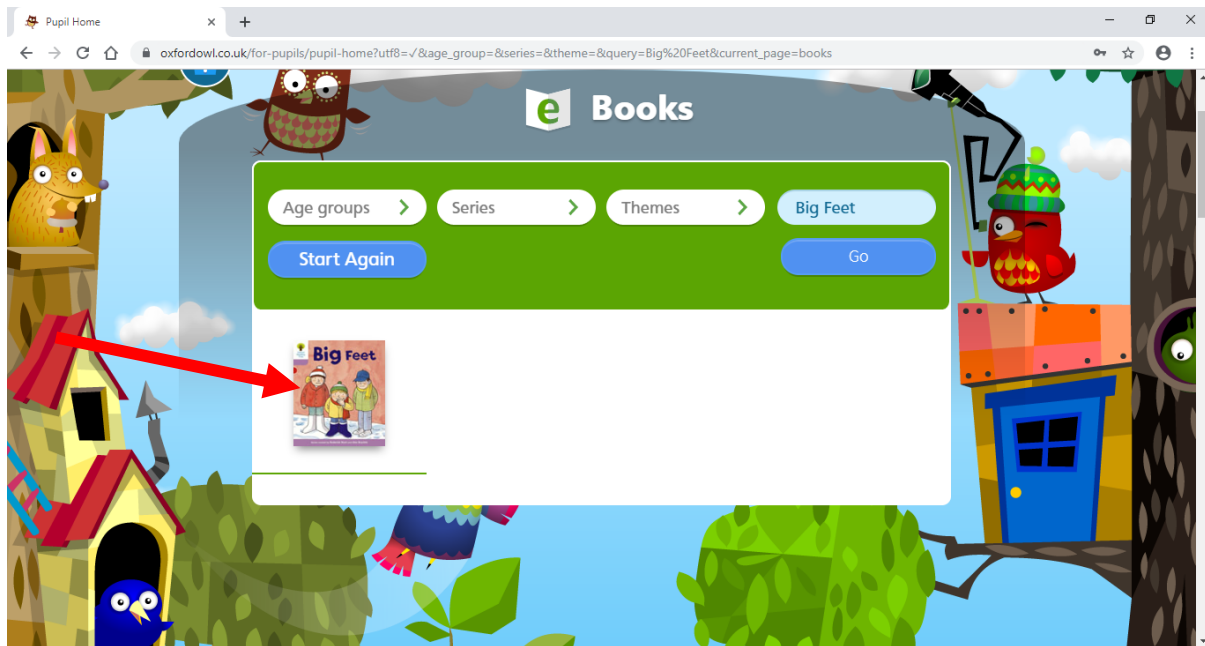
4. Click on 'My Bookshelf'.



5. In the search box type the title of the story and click 'Go'.



6. Click on the picture of the book.



7. Use the bottom arrow buttons beside 'Turn' to move between the pages.



8. There are useful parent tips for **before** reading the book and **during** reading the book when you turn to the first page.

BEFORE READING
Talk together
Look at the cover and read the title together.
Ask your child who might have made these footprints.
Look through the book and talk about the pictures.

About the words in this book
Your child should be able to sound out and blend some words, which may include:
a at is it and big
Dad
Some words may be more challenging. Encourage or model blending, then read the words below to your child if necessary.
no come look this monster dinosaur giant

DURING READING
Enjoy the story together. If your child needs support to read the words:
Ask your child to point from left to right under each word whilst reading.
Model how to sound out and blend new words, if necessary.
If a word is still too tricky, simply say the whole word for your child.
Use the pictures to talk about the story and learn the meaning of new words.

9. If you would like the computer to read aloud the title or any pages, click the Audio play button when you are on the page you would like to hear. If you would like it to stop reading aloud, press the stop button.

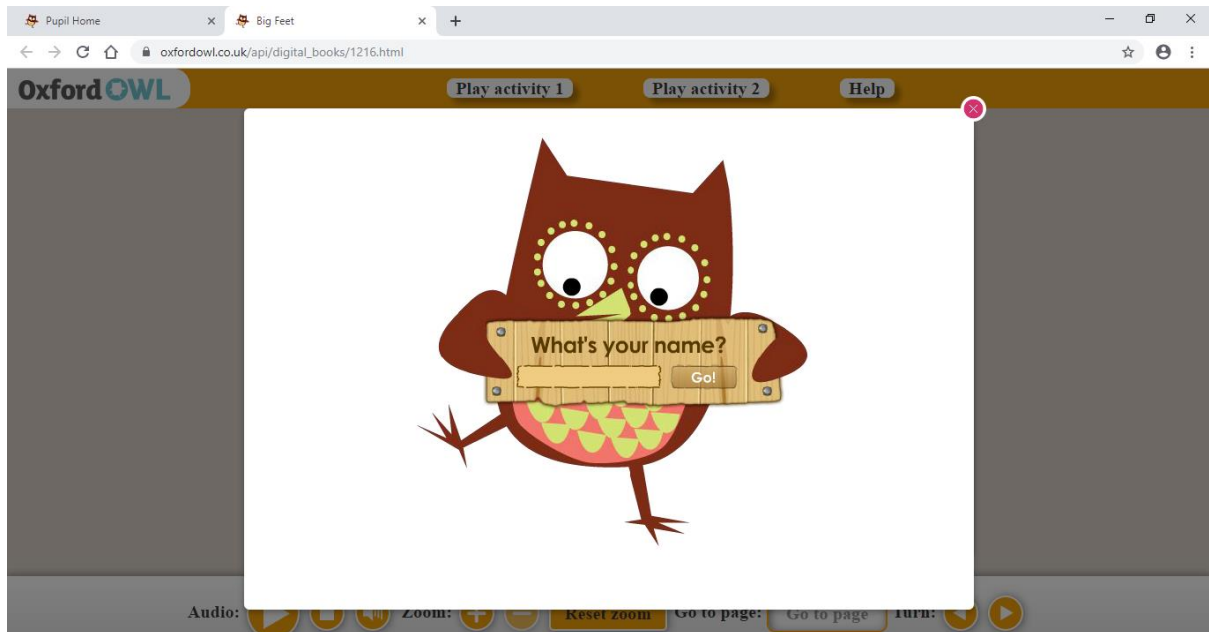

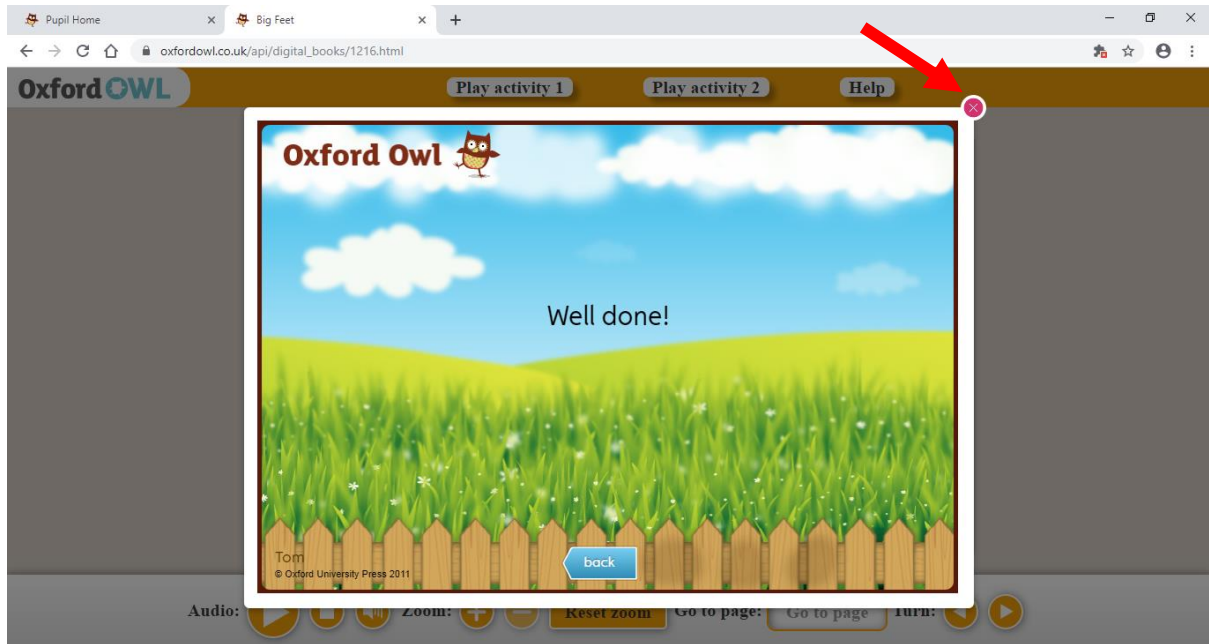
12. Please encourage your child to type their name into the box and then click 'Go!'.



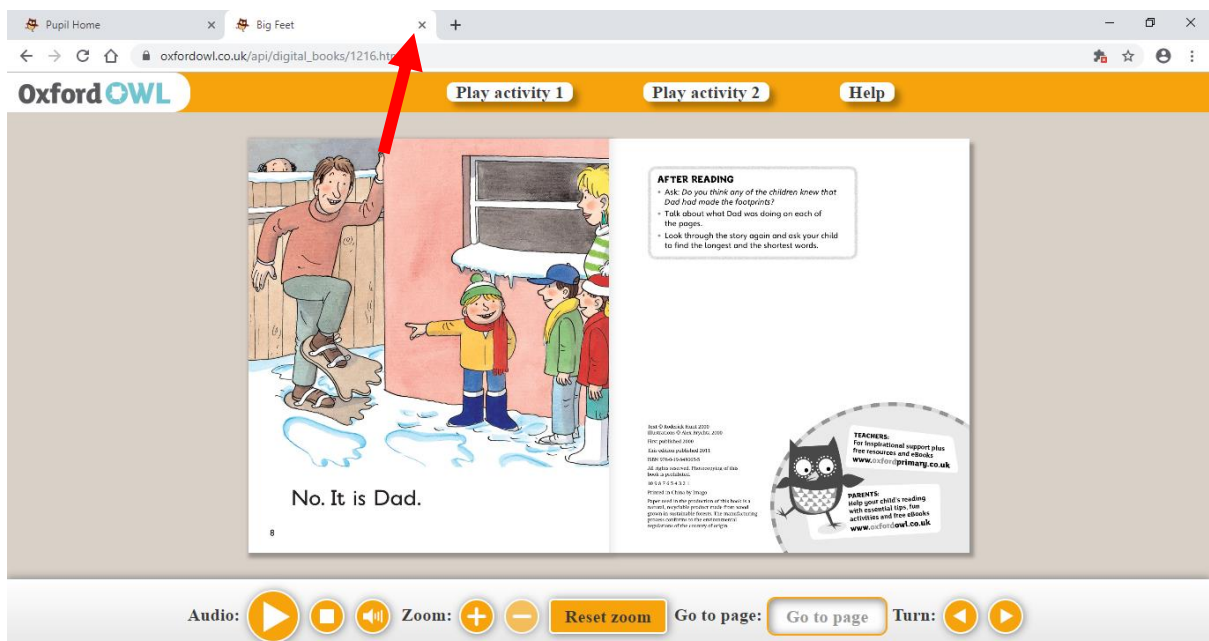
13. Play the activity (this will be different for each book). Once your child has completed the first activity, click the tick to mark the work. If they get it correct they will see a tick and if they get it incorrect they will see a cross. They need to click the tick again to allow them to amend their answer if it is incorrect, or to click 'Next' to see the next part of the game.



14. Once the game has been completed click the red cross button to take you back to the book. You can play any other activities for the book.



15. Once you are finished the book, click the small cross on the tab.



16. Click 'Log out' when you are finished using this website.
