




 <p><b>Languages</b></p>	<p><u>Phonics:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When we have 'magic e' at the end of a word it is usually silent, but changes the pronunciation of the vowel just before it to its long letter sound (as in the alphabet song).
