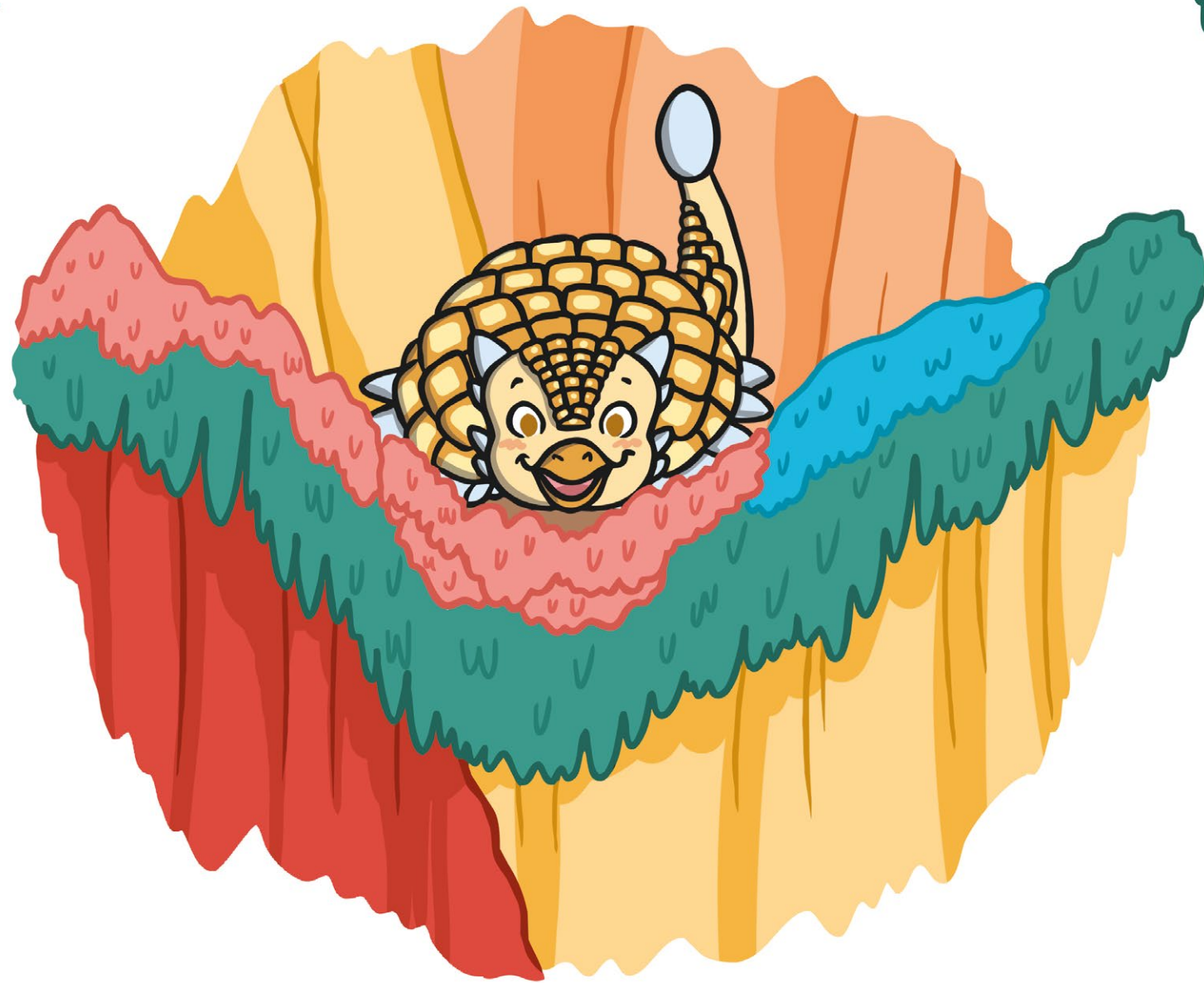

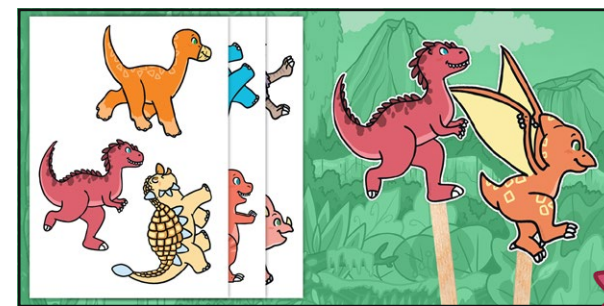
Pterodactyl Peg

Wing and Body: Felt-tip pens
Template: Wooden pegs, Coloured card, Googly eyes
Glue stick, Scissors

Instructions:

- Colour the entire outside of the peg using the felt-tip pens. Greens, yellows and oranges are great ideas colours!
- Draw around the Wing and Body Template onto a piece of card and then carefully cut it out. Colour the body and wings the same colour as your peg.
- Now, pinch the wooden peg so it opens and put the cardboard body and wings in the opening. Release the peg to secure the body and wings.
