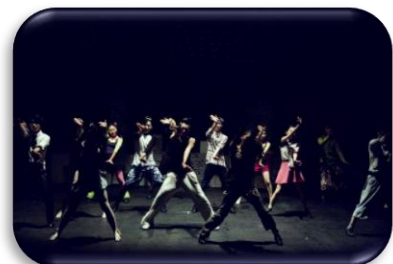
Computer Programming

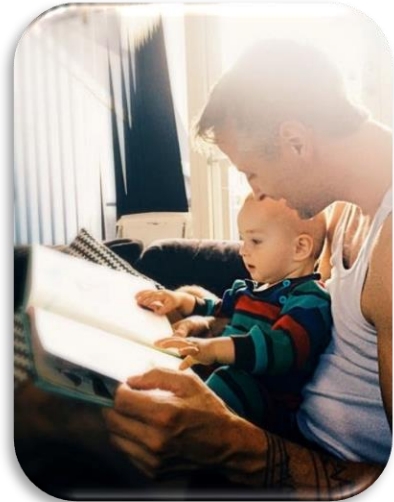
