





Curricular Area	Tasks
 <p data-bbox="120 389 302 454">Numeracy & Mathematics</p>	<p>Main Activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we're focusing on angles and directions, particularly right angled turns. Today our focus is on following directions.
