Curricular Area Tasks Main Activity: This week we're focusing on angles and directions, particularly right angled turns. · Today our focus is on following directions. Check out your activities on Seesaw, and for Numeracy & each adventure, put your finger on the 'Start Here' box, follow the directions and see Mathematics where you end up (You'll be able to write on top of your sheet in Seesaw) **Active Activity:** Try and find as many right angles as you can around the house, or by looking outside through your windows. You can use your 'Right Angle Finders' to help if you wish. Reading: Read Chapter 1 of 'The Legend of Spud Murphy' by Eoin Colfer with an adult at home, making sure to practise any tricky words. (Digital Copy of Book on Seesaw) • Draw a picture of something in Chapter 1, or click on the microphone icon to record Languages yourself reading part of it. You could even do both! (Seesaw Activity) Phonics: This week our sound is 'u-e' as in 'June' · Choose a spelling activity from your active spelling menu to practice your 'u-e' words Social Studies: Weather - Make a Rain Gauge 1) Using any bottle, jar etc that you have available put a few stones in the bottom of it to weigh it down. Other 2) Using a ruler, mark out a scale in centimetres. Curricular 3) Fill the jar with water up to Ocm. Areas 4) Place outside in an open area. 5) Check every couple of days and keep a note of the rainfall where you live.
