



It is used by people who are deaf or have hearing impairments. You may have seen a person standing behind our First Minister using sign language. The fingerspelling alphabet is used in sign language to spell out names of people and places for which there is not a sign.</li> <li>Using the attached finger spelling sheet see if you can spell out your name using the letters or perhaps those in your family. You might be interested to learn the whole alphabet (this isn't essential!) or use the finger spelling alphabet to learn your spelling words.</li> </ul>
