1. Welcome

Mr McDonald welcomed everyone and congratulated all councillors on being elected to Maidenhill's very first pupil council. Emme was then elected as Pupil Council Chair, with Eva and Oscar as her deputies.

2. Vision, Values and Aims Steering Group

Mr McDonald explained the role of the pupil council in taking responsibility for leading school improvements over the year. He highlighted the importance of the school identifying our vision, values and aims through a steering group. All councillors agreed that they would like to get involved in this important work.

3. Important Events

Mr McDonald explained that the whole-school nativity would be an important event next term. The council agreed that it would be a good idea to sell tickets for this to raise money for school funds.

4. Fundraising

It was agreed that this should happen after play time. **Councillors will be responsible for reporting this back to their teachers.**
