Supported Study Initiative

As part of our overall recovery strategy, all of our teachers in P1-7 have volunteered to run Rollercoaster Readers or Mind-blowing Mathematicians clubs for some of the children in each class. These will run over the course of next term as either a weekly after-school club or a twice-weekly lunchtime club. These groups will allow some of our children to consolidate core skills in a small-group, active, games-based context. Teachers are inviting small groups of children for whom this approach will hopefully be impactful and further information should have been e-mailed to relevant parents/ carers today.

This is just one way in which teachers are eagerly supporting our children following the extended period of lockdown last session and we recognise that all children may benefit from a range of new approaches over the course of this session- this is something we are continuing to monitor and track on an ongoing basis.

Nursery Class Update

Thank you for the feedback you provided on our care and support during COVID. It was lovely to hear such positive views with regards to how we have continued to support your children in their return/ start of nursery. Our nursery staff team have worked tirelessly to make sure all children feel safe, secure and loved in our setting and your feedback as shown that this has not been in vain.

As we move in to the new term, our staff have been consulting with the children about what they would like to learn, and preparing them for a small change upon their return after next week. Each group of children and staff will be moving to a different zone in the nursery. This will ensure that children continue to have a breadth of experiences, inside and outdoors, and are able to continue to develop their skills in the full range of contexts. I'm sure that the children will be able to share their excitement with you about this move.

We appreciate that we need to open different channels of communication with you – we wish we could go back to welcoming you inside the nursery when your children are being collected and provide feedback on their day but, given the current circumstances, this is not possible. As an alternative, we aim to begin regular phone calls home to you in the new term, as well as having a weekly post on the nursery google classroom to keep you in the loop with the different learning experiences the children have been engaging in throughout the week.
