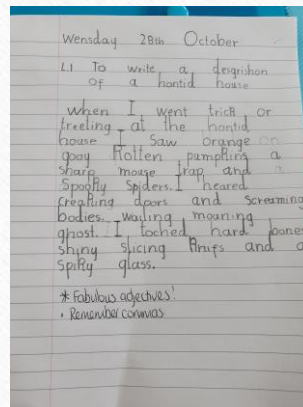
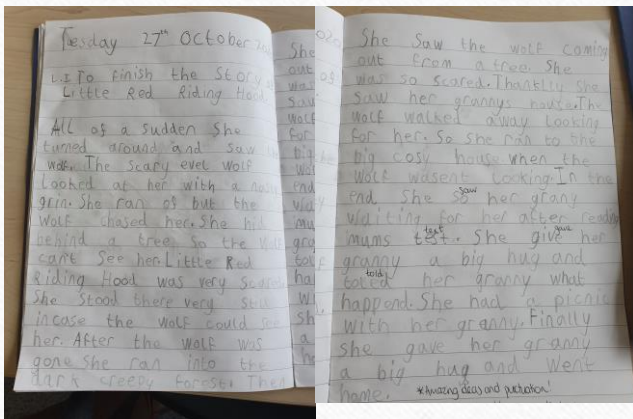

Every morning we begin the first 30 minutes of our day with our Kickstart session. These are hands-on, play based activities that warm - up our brains and consolidate prior learning.



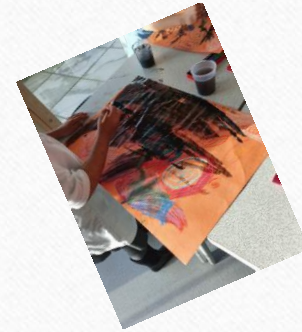
