#### Dear Parents/ Carers

It seems like a lifetime ago when the biggest thing we had to worry about at this time of year was that, no matter how carefully and conscientiously you tell yourself you packed them away last year, an unknown perpetrator has managed to access your loft and mix up all your Christmas lights and leave them tangled in an old Asda baq!

As we enter a further period of yet more uncertainty, the fragility of the current situation continues to be highlighted. After almost 2 years of peaks and troughs however, I am more than used to uncertainty—always planning for the best, but preparing for the worst. We are starting to enter that end of term 'danger zone' where any instruction to isolate could potentially have an impact on at least the first week of everyone's holiday. With the introduction of the new isolation instructions in relation to the Omicron variant, being fully vaxxed or having a negative PCR no longer negates the need to isolate. This is a time when, as a community, we will all want to do our best to exercise caution. I certainly wouldn't want to see any of our staff members or parents/ families isolating over the holiday, but I definitely don't want to think of any of our children being in that position.

It can be easy sometimes in a school and nursery class to feel that you are being too cautious; at other times, not cautious enough. It can be a difficult balancing act based on a lot of factors specific to our context, but with the children at the heart of our decision-making I feel confident, even when we adults are all having to make sacrifices, we are doing our very best to get that balance right for the children.

## Christmas Jumper Day

We kick off the official festive calendar on Monday with Christmas Jumper Day. If they wish, children can come to school or nursery class dressed for a winter wonderland- reindeer antlers, santa hats, added sparkle all allowed.

Please note we will limit Christmas jumpers to this day and, apart from the days of the children's Christmas parties, full uniform is expected right up until the end of term.

#### Christmas Parties

Speaking of Christmas parties (now frowned upon in wider society, but still thankfully OK for us in school), the children in P1-7 will all have a snack of either ready salted Walkers crisps or Pom Bears, plus a Freddo and some sugar-free diluting juice. Our nursery children will have Pom Bears, sugar-free juice and their very own self-made Christmas biscuits.
