Aldi stands for Albrecht Discount. In 1913 Karl and Anna Albrecht founded a food store in a small mining area of Germany, this is where Anna trained her sons, Karl and Theo in the retail trade. By 1947 the brothers had decided to expand the business and during the 1950's they had opened around 300 stores. Karl and Theo went their separate ways with their businesses in 1960 with Theo establishing his business as Aldi North, and Karl with his business; Aldi South.

ALDI opened the first UK store in 1990, and have now established a network of over 500 stores nationwide which is supported by 9 strategically placed Regional offices and Distribution centres. ALDI prides itself on offering high quality products at low prices as well as still being able to offer an excellent customer experience. This can only be achieved by recruiting the right people into the business.

Apprenticeships at ALDI are seen as an excellent route into the business and you could be offered a management position within 3 years.

If you are successful and start your Apprenticeship with ALDI you will be offered a fixed term 12 month contract for your first year. For retail you will start to complete your Store Assistant training whilst undertaking an NVQ Level 2 in Retail Skills with our training partner First 4 Skills. You will be regularly assessed and reviewed, and if you complete everything successfully you will be offered a 24 month contract, and will start to complete Deputy Store Manager training whilst undertaking an NVQ Level 3 in Retail Management. At the end of the 3 years we hope we would be in a position to offer you either a Deputy Store Manager contract, or for those that have exceeded our expectations an Assistant Store Manager contract.

In Logistics you will start to complete the Selector training whilst undertaking an NVQ Level 2 in Warehouse and Distribution with our training partner First 4 Skills. If you complete everything successfully you will be offered a 24 month contract and will start to complete Warehouse deputy training whilst undertaking an NVQ Level 3 in Warehouse & Distribution. At the end of the 3 years we would be looking to offer you a Warehouse deputy contract with further opportunities to progress in the future.
