However, purchases will only be able to be made during the times when the Book Sale is open to parents and families, and therefore, **children should not bring any money into school please**. We hope that these arrangements will be supportive of all our families' individual circumstances and ease any additional pressure to make purchases. 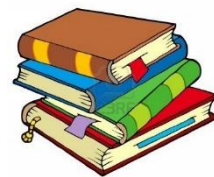
Unfortunately, we are unable to take electronic payments therefore, please make **cash purchases only**.
