Section 22	 Can only be made in exceptional emergency situations To help promote the needs of the child if help is unable to be provided in some other way 	 Purchase of food, fuel, clothing or furniture Vouchers to purchase any of the above A payment to a third party In exceptional circumstances, cash To support Immediate need that can't wait any length of time No Recourse to Public funds 	 Regular or ongoing costs Items, goods or services that can be accessed within a reasonable time from another source (eg Sofa from SWF) Higher amounts (without express approval of Head of Service) Cannot be used for accommodation or maintenance of the child Receiving Continuing Care payments from HSCP 	 Via HSCP: A team manager can authorise payments of up to £50 A Service manager can authorise payments from £51 - £500 Anything over £500 must be approved by the Chief Social Work Officer
