

The GROW £1 Challenge

Next week, P5 are celebrating Chinese New Year and the traditions associated with this celebration. On this special day across the world children who celebrate Chinese New Year wake up to find red envelopes filled with money under their pillows.

So on Monday, we would like to surprise our children in P5 with a red envelope that will be placed on their desks in the morning with £1 enclosed. We then thought it would be a nice idea to combine this take on the Chinese tradition with a fundraising idea. This idea is called the **Grow £1 Challenge** and is a mini enterprise project.

How does it work?

The challenge will take place from Monday 23rd January till Tuesday 28th February.

The school will donate £1 to every P5 child who wants to take part. The challenge is to then turn the £1 into £2, or more, by taking part in a fundraising/entrepreneurial project.

Funds can be raised individually or the children may want to form a small group to fundraise together.

We will discuss this challenge project with each class and generate ideas with the children on Tuesday. We will then discuss which charity the class would like to donate the money to and this will be shared with you once a class decision has been made.

We will post the ideas your child's class generates on google classroom on Tuesday. Your child can chose one of these ideas or take part in one of their own.
