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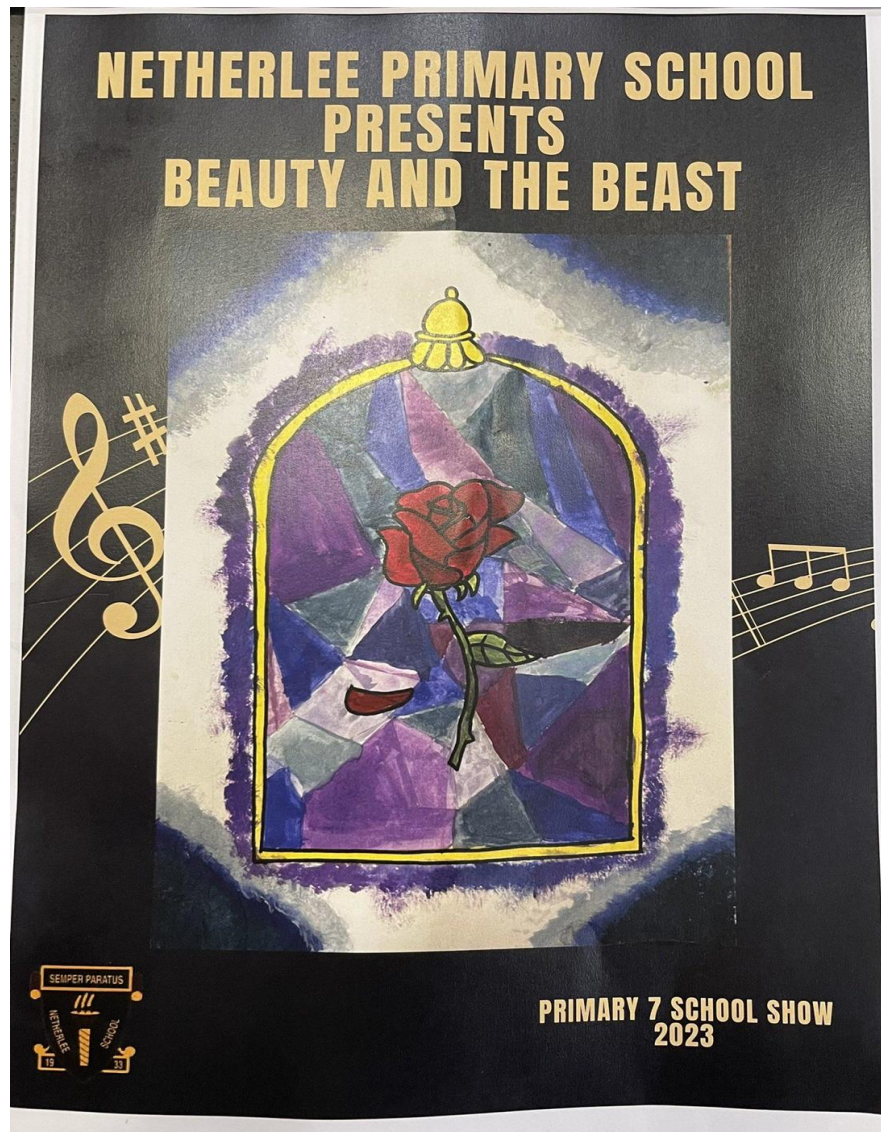

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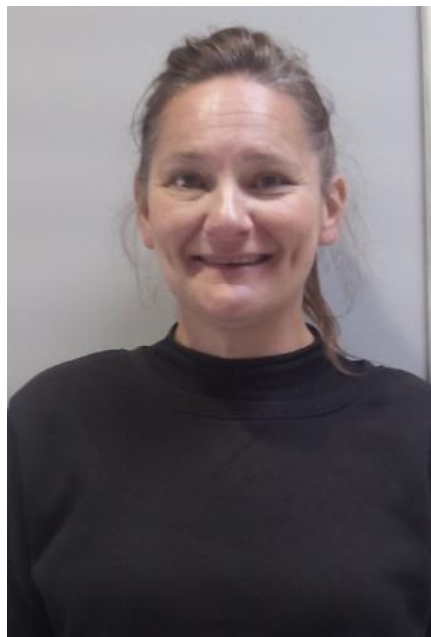
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# MEET THE P4 TEACHERS

**Amy: "I liked all the colours on us and I liked the fact that we all got sprayed with colour".**

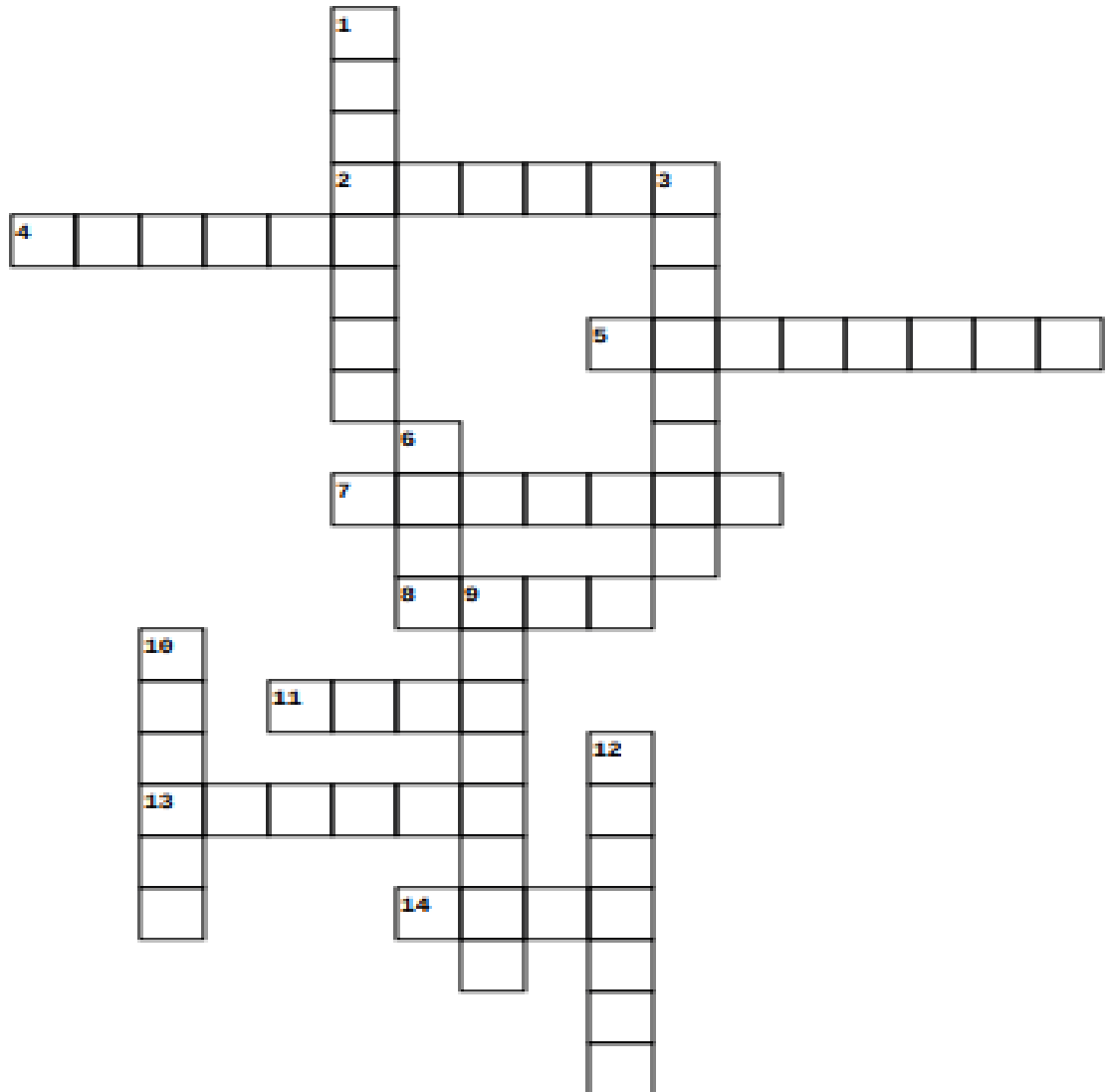
**Innes: "I really liked it but it tasted disgusting! And I really liked it when they threw it back at us."**
