WHAT IS GME?

HOW DOES IT LOOK IN EAST RENFREWSHIRE?

In Gaelic Medium Education the main language of the classroom is Gaelic. Your child does not need to speak Gaelic already – many children enter P1 with no prior knowledge of the language. The immersion approach supports them to learn Gaelic while also developing their literacy, numeracy and wider learning skills.

In P1-3 Gaelic is the sole language of learning across the whole curriculum. In P4-7 English is introduced alongside Gaelic. This supports learners to develop English and Gaelic literacy to the same level by the end of P7.

Our provision is based within Thornliebank Primary School, enjoying the shared playground and facilities and contributing to the life of the school.

HOW TO APPLY FOR PRIMARY 1

The catchment area for our Gaelic Medium provision is the whole of East Renfrewshire and residents should apply in the usual way, online in December. When applying you can select Gaelic Medium Education.

Transport is provided from home to school for East Renfrewshire residents.

If you live outside East Renfrewshire, placing requests should be made in the normal way.
