Everyone Attaining

- We are helping all children to read. Children in school all get a chance to learn equally, we are also working on understanding the texts we read and using our comprehension skills to help
- We will have more opportunities for reading for pleasure with our parents and carers from Nursery to P3. Our needs, interests and home languages, and our classroom and playroom settings will help us to recognise sounds and words in Nursery,
- Through using the Big Question in learning, we are given the correct amount of support and challenge. Choosing what and how we learn will help our teachers understand us as learners in different curricular areas. Our teachers will help us improve our meta-skills with more confidence.
- We will invite families of children who require extra support, into school and nursery, so they can and help their children and feel part of our school community.

Everyone Achieving

- We will work together to create or curriculum and share our reasons for this, working with local businesses to help all children to be fully included in the classroom.
- We are going to support all staff to understand and use the six principles of Nurture in the school and nursery. Using PANECAL in the nursery will make sure our words and voices and heard and respected. This will help our speech and language to get better.
- We will all be learning Makaton.
- Diversity is celebrated across our school and nursery. The way we speak, the displays we have and the things we use in class encourage us to be fair. Staff will help us if we are unfairly discriminated against.
- Everyone is given opportunities to lead activities across the school. This gives us the chance to share our skills with staff and children.
- Children's achievements are respected and shared with the whole school and staff achievements help to make our school even better by sharing their skills with others.

Excellent Experiences

- All school and nursery staff will understand *The Promise* and be able to help children in the right way.
- We will have more opportunities in school and nursery to take part in Froebelian practices such as weaving and woodwork. Staff will use the Leuven Scales to support and challenge us in our learning.
- Staff will learn and become more confident using new ways of teaching problem solving in Maths, meaning we will have more time to practise these skills in flexible Maths groups. Different assessments will help us to understand our next steps
