Children will also have the opportunity to visit our Book Sale during the school and nursery day throughout the first week to browse books and stationary however, purchases will only be able to be made during the times when the Book Sale is open to parents and families as detailed above, and therefore, children should not bring any money into school or nursery. There is absolutely no need to make any purchases at all and we hope that these arrangements will be supportive of all our families' individual circumstances and ease any additional pressures. Unfortunately, we are unable to take electronic payments at the Book Sale, therefore, all payments for purchases require to be **made in cash please**. To help with the practicalities of cash transactions we would appreciate it if we could round up to the nearest 50p or pound e.g. an item costing £2.99 will be rounded to £3.00 or an item costing £2.49 will be rounded £2.50 etc. Any extra 'small change' will go to school funds to be used to support learning experiences for all pupils.

In addition, any profits made will be used, as they are each year, to enhance the range of literacy resources and variety of texts that are available for our children to enjoy in school and nursery.
