Frequently Asked Questions

Q – Do I need experience?

A – Yes, however it can be gained through babysitting (out with family), volunteering with children e.g., Scouts, BB, clubs, childminding, sports clubs or employment.

Q – What will my hours of work be?

A – 22.5hrs per week no evening or weekend work
Morning shift is 7:45am to 9am, then returning for the
Afternoon shift 2:45*pm to 6*pm.

Term time only, Holiday work subject to demand . * Some projects are afternoon only, and start times may vary

Q – What will I get paid?

A – Starting pay £9.50 per hour.

Q – What will I wear?

A – Uniform provided - MACS Polo Shirt/ hoodie and you can wear casual comfy trousers and shoes.

Q – What Qualifications can I achieve?

A – To begin with SQA Playwork SCQF Level6, Forest Kindergarten SCQF Level7, progressing to SSCYP Level7.

Q – Do I get paid holidays?

A – Yes (including 9 Public holidays).

Q – Requirements of a Support Worker?

A – All staff must undergo Protection of Vulnerable Groups scheme checks, SSSC Registration, Reference checks and be able to provide at least 1 Childcare Reference (out with the family).
