We would also invite anyone who cannot manage to our Oratory at this time to join with us in prayer.

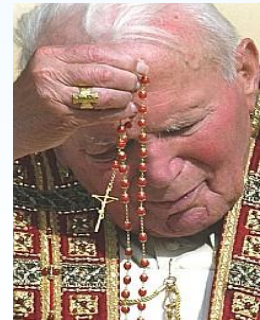


# The Rosary

# SCHOOL PROCEDURES





# Registering – Period 1

- Pupils should be in class by the time the second bells sounds (8.45am)
- Teachers will complete their registers by 9am.
- If you arrive to school after 9am you **must** sign in at the office.

# Registering – Period 2 - 7

- Pupils should arrive to class, and be prepared to work, on time.
- Period 5 - Pupils should be in class by the time the second lunch bell goes (at 1pm). If you arrive after this you will be marked late.
- **It is your responsibility to arrive to class on time and be ready to work.**



# Appointments

- If you have an appointment out of school you should get a note signed by your Pastoral Teacher.
- You must use this note to sign out at the office.
- If you are returning to school after an appointment you **must** sign in at the school office before going to class. This is **always** the case.

# Corridor Conduct

- Take care for your own safety and that of other people
- Keep to the left and in a single file when the corridor is busy.

- When moving between classes, go quickly and quietly
- When moving around the school, follow the directions given by teachers

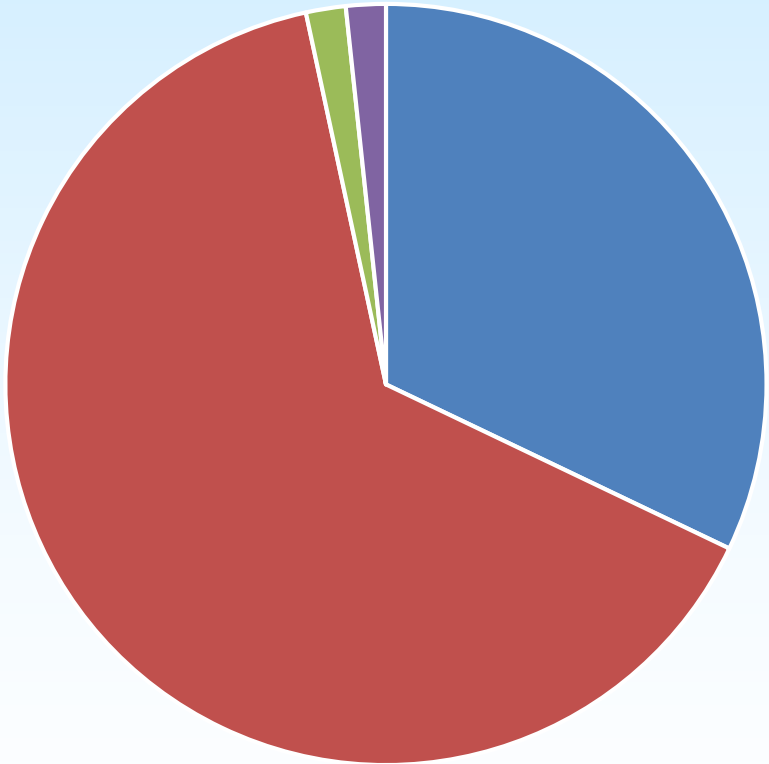

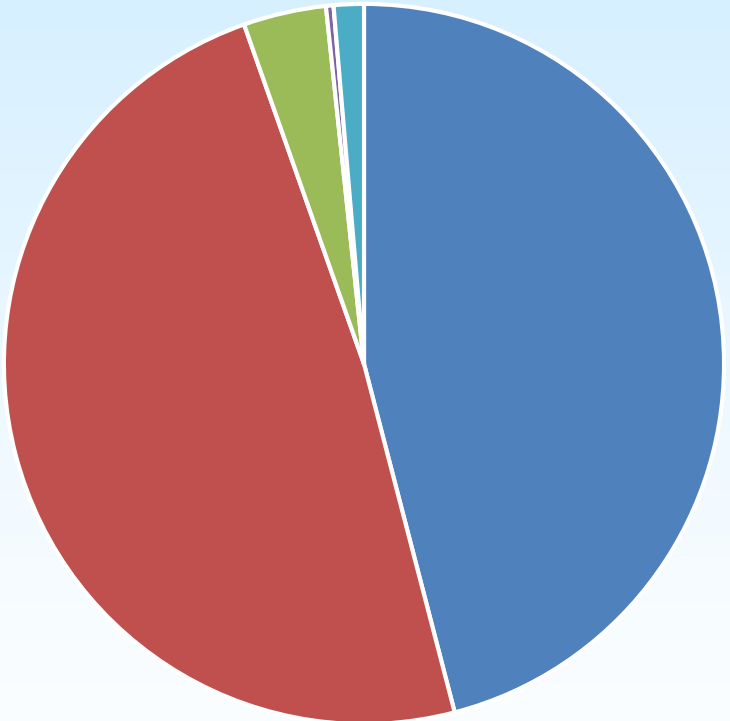

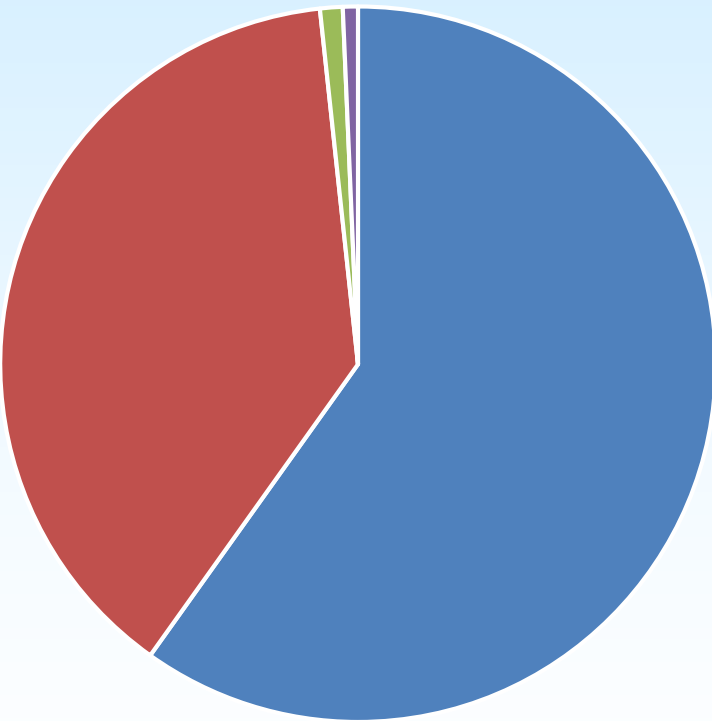

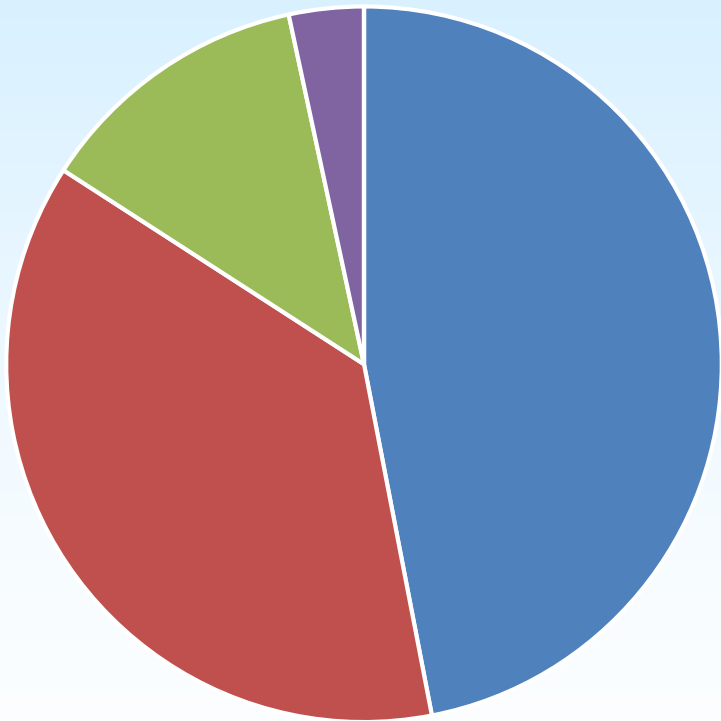
