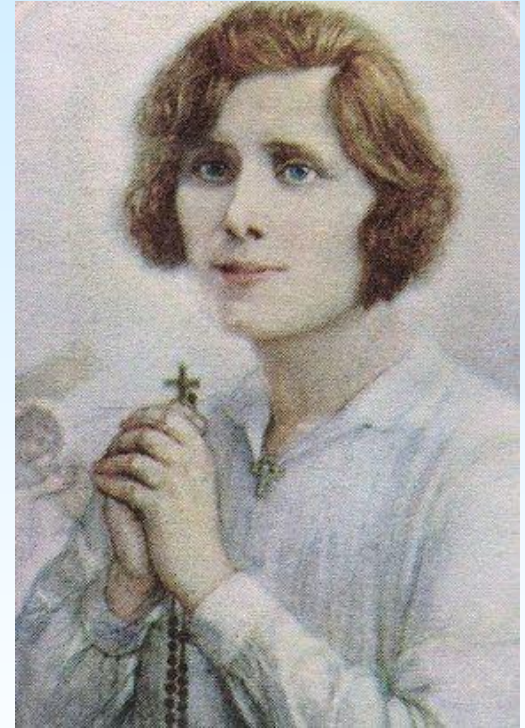
Venerable Margaret Sinclair Novena

We would also invite anyone who cannot manage to our Oratory at this time to join with us in prayer.

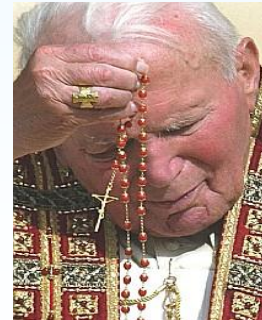


The Rosary

Alpe D'Huez 2020



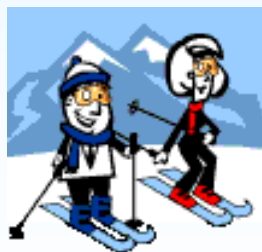
- A fantastic opportunity for pupils to learn/improve their skiing in a real mountain environment but also mature and grow in confidence as young people.

This year, our theme is 'Biology at its best!'

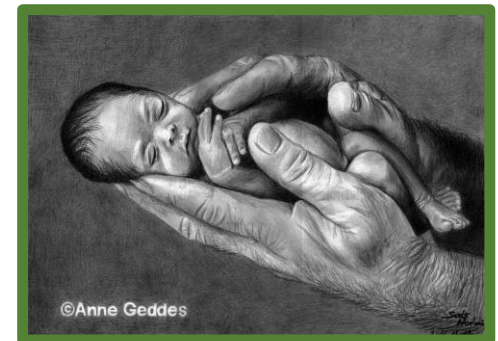

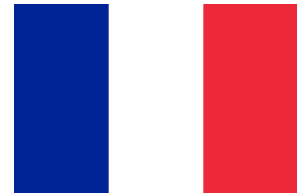

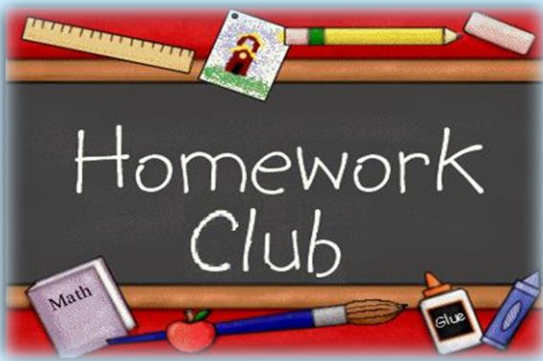
