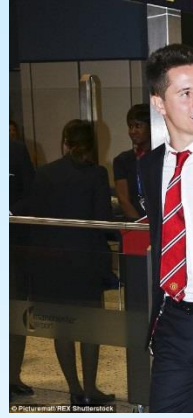


Our School and Community

Toilet

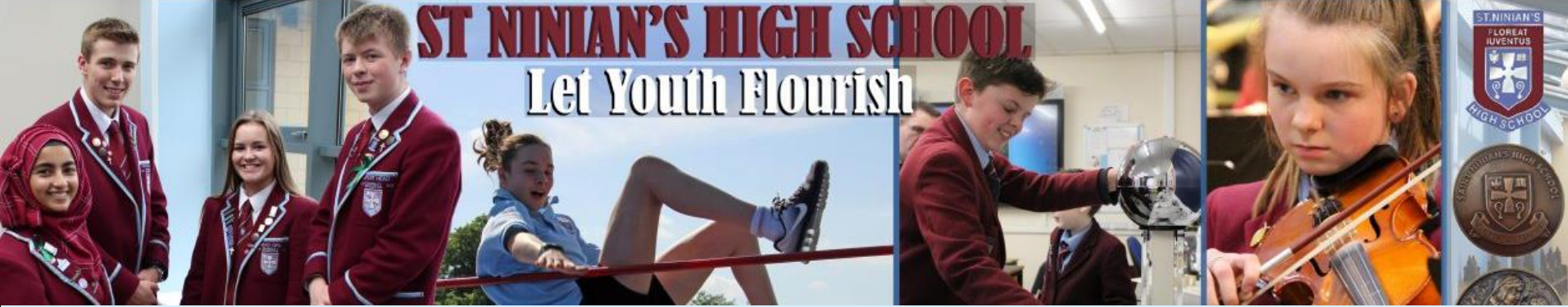
- No going to the toilet during classes.
