As our school is closed we have put together this guidance to support your child with access to their learning remotely. It is essential we continue to provide progressive and consolidatory activities and experiences for all children. All guidance and digital resources provided, aim to promote child led learning with a focus on developing problem solving, critical thinking and independence.

At St. Clare's we value Mental Health above all and recognise that this is unprecedented times where the children may feel anxiety and uncertainty, as well as yourselves. Our class teachers are available to answer queries about learning via google classroom and the Senior Leadership Team are on hand to answer any other questions you may have via school mail.

Digital set up

All pupils have been provided with usernames and passwords for Glow, Google Classroom, Education City, Literacy Planet and IDL (if applicable) so they can access learning activities from home using a digital device. Please send your child's teacher a message via google classroom if you require them again.

Remote working/sharing learning guidance

- As much as possible your child will be working through a weekly timetable of literacy, numeracy, Health and Well Being and R.E. activities.
- Class teachers will upload weekly/daily assignments for your child to complete.
- Learning will be progressive, however, some consolidation work may be provided as appropriate.
- Children must ensure all tasks are submitted using the 'Hand in' function with a photo, if possible, this will support the assessment of children's on going progress.
- Learning is compulsory and if you are experiencing any issues with engagement please contact your child's class teacher or a member of the senior leadership team.
- Your child's Class Teacher will arrange a pastoral Google meet each week with their class. This
 is for the Senior Leadership team and class teacher to keep in contact directly with your child.
 Any parental queries should go through google classroom or school mail.
